

China-Italy for Health : what works, what next

November 6, 2020

FOREWORD:

China and Italy look to the future of "public health" with a long-term vision. The two countries can collaborate on the entire health chain, with total solutions for health authorities, hospitals and territories. The collaboration could be extended to the design of care units, pharma, health services, management structures for acute and chronic patients, staff training, highly innovative technological solutions, management of pre-commercial and clinical trials observation. Science and research offer fields of collaboration that are still unexplored, while there are many opportunities suggested by reciprocal development plans. The new Italian and Chinese hubs on Life Sciences have very advanced scientific and technological prospects. Shanghai Jiao Tong University and its Hospitals system host one of the most advanced biomedical research hub in China. In Milan, the new Innovation District, created in the areas of Expo 2015, hosts the Human Technopole and MIND, the hub on Life Sciences. Innovation in the life sciences will exclusively depend on how a huge amount of information is produced, in addition to how extensively and simply it is shared.

ACTION:

- spotlight the science commons in life science and health research in China and Italy;
- identify some scientific and technological paths for the Italy-China collaboration through the presentation of the two systems of research on Life Sciences in Shanghai and Milan, with their hubs for excellence in the fields of healthcare, biotech, pharma, nutrition, data science, big data;
- consider the Italian and Chinese contexts of an increasingly elderly population, and the consequent increase in chronic diseases, the risks associated with viral diseases;
- evaluate the technological opportunities of advanced diagnostics (e-health) and integrated care and assistance for the elderly;
- enhance organizations to build resilient communities, help all people live with dignity, and improve health and well-being.

From 2007 to 2016 he was Assistant Professor at the Department of Internal Medicine, Division of Rheumatology, Allergy, and Clinical Immunology, School of Medicine, University of California at Davis (USA) from 2007 to 2016.
